

China Arrival Checklist for Crypto Travelers

A compact pre-flight checklist for entering China with payment, connectivity, ride-hailing, maps, hotel handoff, and local support prepared before you land.

Use this for	First-time China arrivals, Web3 / crypto travelers, business visitors, event trips, and anyone paying CCAC service fees in USDT.
Main warning	Do not wait until the airport to solve payment, data, Didi, maps, or hotel address friction.
Boundary	No anonymous SIM, no account selling, no USDT-to-Alipay wallet transfer, no fake IDs, no rule bypassing.

1. Before booking flight

- Confirm destination city, arrival airport, hotel status, visa / entry requirements, phone compatibility, and whether your bank cards are eligible for tourist payment paths.
- Decide whether you need only Comms Setup, the full Landing Kit, or Mission Control for the first 48 hours.

2. Before boarding

- Install Alipay, WeChat / Weixin Pay, Didi, maps, translation, Telegram, and WhatsApp before departure.
- Set up travel eSIM or roaming, keep your original number reachable for verification, and save your hotel address in Chinese.

3. First hour after landing

- Get online first. If eSIM or roaming fails, use airport Wi-Fi as a fallback and message your support channel before trying to solve everything alone.
- Open the prepared ride, address, and hotel handoff notes before leaving the terminal.

4. Payment setup

- Use official tourist payment paths first: Alipay and WeChat / Weixin Pay with your own eligible international card.
- Do not rely on USDT-to-wallet top-up promises, gray-market accounts, or pre-logged phones.

5. Connectivity setup

- Most short trips can begin with travel eSIM or roaming. If you truly need a China phone number, use an official passport-based SIM registration path after arrival.
- Do not buy or request anonymous SIM cards.

6. Didi / maps / hotel address

- Save the hotel name, district, full address, and phone number in Chinese. Confirm airport pickup point, driver contact, luggage needs, and hotel check-in timing.
- Keep these details in one support thread so you can move from airport to hotel without rebuilding context.

7. What CCAC can and cannot do

- CCAC is a USDT-paid China arrival operating layer for payment setup, connectivity, rides, hotels, essentials, and first-window support.
- CCAC is not a taxi company, travel agency, account seller, money exchange, fake ID service, or rule-bypass service.
